Hallowe'en 31st October

Hallowe'en (e'en = evening) means the evening before All Saints Day, when people prepared to remember those who had died. Nowadays it has become an evening for children to trick or treat, have parties, carve pumpkins and put candles inside them, tell ghost stories and watch horror films. Some people go to church to light candles to remember their loved ones who have passed away.

All Saints Day 1st November

All Saints Day is a Christian festival celebrated in honour of all known and unknown saints. All Saints Day is the day before All Souls Day and some people celebrate by putting flowers and candles on the graves of their loved ones. They also give prayers and blessings for their passed loved ones in heaven.

It is believed by many that there is a powerful spiritual bond between those in heaven and the living.


All Souls Day 2nd November
